Images clockwise:

The procession leaves the quire singing the processional prose.

It moves round the far eastern aisles.

Then, having passed through the south transept, it goes around the cloisters.

Having re-entered the nave, it moves eastwards.

It re-enters the quire, singing an antiphon to the patron saint.
