# ST TEILO'S CHURCH PRAYER & DEVOTION



## ANTIPHON OF THE CROSS

*Three images from above, clockwise*

The people kneel in the nave, focusing their prayer on the figures of the Rood above the pulpitum.

The Rood: Christ crucified, his mother and St John.

After Vespers on Saturday in the summer, the singers move from chancel to nave to sing an Antiphon of the Cross before the Rood.



## IMAGES OF DEVOTION

*Three images from right, clockwise*

At the end of the day, nuns on pilgrimage sing the antiphon to the Blessed Virgin Mary, *Salve Regina*.

Just before communion, the priest kisses the chalice, then the Pax. The Pax is then brought for each to kiss.

A pilgrim recites her rosary before an image of a saint, while a villager prays devoutly.
